Creating a small mound with long, slim branches that extend outward, it's a very versatile plant that will surprise you with its strength and capabilities. Seen all over Australia from Southern Queensland, Tasmania and Western Australia, Cousin It™ will complement many gardens and create a very trendy style with a real design flare.

The leafless stems create a thick mat and natural mulch, and its spreading habit can cover large areas quickly, hiding just about anything from unsightly drainage pipes, stumps and other ground obstacles. Cousin It™ also creates a spectacular effect when cascading and spilling over embankments, retaining walls and rockeries.
