Introducing ane exceptional new Arctotis offering huge, crimson red flowers up to 8cm in diameter. The near black centre and halo of yellow adds to the intense visual impact this plant presents.

Fireball has the durability, strength and long flowering of Arctotis, with flowers raised above the strong, deep silver green foliage. Flowering from mid winter to late summer, this variety is bound to stand out and get noticed in any garden setting.
