







VACCINIUM BLUEBERRY

Blue Rose / H: 1.8m W: 1.5m

Blue Rose is a tall, vigorous plant that is best suited to cooler climates. It's a deciduous variety that produces good autumn foliage and particularly large berries that need to be left on the plant until the last minute as they won't ripen after picking.

Sunshine Blue / H: 1.2m W: 1.2m

Sunshine Blue is a compact rounded deciduous shrub with silvery green leaves. Sunshine Blue has low chill requirements and can tolerate more acidic soils. It produces multitudes of medium, sweet, dark blue fruit in summer.

Northland / H: 2m W: 1.5m

Northland is a compact, dense, deciduous shrub that has excellent winter hardiness. It produces white flowers that ripen to very dark fleshed berries with a wild blueberry flavour.
